## STUDY and WORK in SPAIN

Spend 10 months (September to June) in Pamplona (Spain). Work as a Spanish instructor while you study and complete an official Spanish MA program in Spanish Second Language Teaching at the Instituto de Lengua y Cultura Españolas (ILCE), Facultad de Filosofía y Letras, Universidad de Navarra (UNAV), number one private university in Spain.

## A GLOBAL PROGRAM

A genuine global approach to your MA program in Spanish. You will teach Spanish to students from all over the world, and you will be taught by professors from UNAV and invited professors from around the globe.

## UNITY OF THEORY AND PRACTICE

A unique MA program in Spanish Second Language Teaching where theory and practice go hand in hand from day one. At ILCE, you will become a Spanish instructor, and will work in teams with experienced professors and researchers in Spanish Applied Linguistics, while you take courses for your MA.

## OUTSTANDING FACULTY

Our programs are taught by outstanding professors from Universidad de Navarra with extensive international experience, and by distinguished invited professors from universities

such as Princeton University, Pennsylvania State University, Georgetown University, Rice University, Rutgers University, University of Oxford (UK), and Kobe University (Japan).

## ACADEMICS

The program is divided into two main semesters (Fall and Spring) and First Summer Session (May-June). Students take four graduate seminars per semester (3 credits each seminar) for a total of 12 graduate credits per semester.

### Fall (12 credits of graduate work plus teaching one class):

- Spanish Language Teaching Methodology
- Second Language Evaluation and Assessment
- Spanish Second Language Acquisition Theory
- Second Language Acquisition Theories

### Spring (12 credits of graduate work plus teaching one class):

- Research and Innovation in the Classroom
- Global Seminars
- Spanish for Specific Purposes
- Technology-Enhanced Language Learning.

### First Summer Session: MA Thesis (3 credits) plus teaching one class.

## PROFESSIONAL FIELD TRIP

Program includes one professional trip to Barcelona for two days.



## CAREER & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Access to an **exclusive pool of international job opportunities** after completing the MA program in North America, Europe, and Asia.

**SUMMER JOBS:** job opportunities available at ILCE.

- **Before MA:** Teaching assistant opportunities exclusive to MA students before beginning the MA program in the Fall.
- **After MA:** Get paid after you complete the MA teaching Spanish at ILCE's Summer courses.

## TUITION AND FEES

**TUITION AND FEES:** 12,405.16 euros\* (\$14,400 approximately) for 75 ECTS (European credits). Includes coursework, supervised teaching (one class per semester), Final MA thesis, and fees.

### ESTIMATED ADDITIONAL EXPENSES:

Students will be responsible for personal costs while in Spain including:

- Airfare to Spain (if not covered by travel grant): \$800-\$1200.
- Lodging (if not included in financial package): \$400-\$900 per month.
- Meals while in Spain (\$150-\$250 per month)
- Personal expenses (\$100-\$200 per month)

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

### Rolling Admissions.

Applicants interested in applying for entry in the 2019-2020 Academic Year will be able to access the application for admission in September 2018.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Merit-based scholarships (up to 30% of tuition) are available for outstanding students.

## FINANCIAL AID

**BASIC TA-ships:** All students accepted into the MA program receive a stipend of 200 euros per month for 10 months (2,000 euros).

**EXTENDED TA-ships:** Additional funding available for qualified and experienced MA students: an extra 375 euros approx. per month when teaching an additional 3 credits course.

**PAID HOUSING:** Scholarships available for international students accepted to the MA program, who may stay at university dorms in double rooms at no cost.

**TRAVEL GRANTS:** Exceptionally qualified international students accepted to the program may receive a travel grant to pay for travel costs (\$1,200).
